1 **AN ACT relating to:** recycling education, research concerning solid waste, and
2 making appropriations.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill provides funding from the recycling fund to the University of Wisconsin System for recycling education and technical assistance and for research into alternative methods of managing solid waste.
