1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 *✓* 1. Page 359, line 1: after that line insert:

4 *“(6)”* STUDY OF THE INSTITUTION OF THE LEGISLATURE. The joint legislative council
5 shall study the manner in which campaigns for election to legislative office are
6 financed and the process by which legislation is considered by the legislature and
7 shall prepare proposed legislation with a view toward reforming the institution of the
8 legislature in the public interest. The joint legislative council shall report its
9 findings, conclusions, and recommendations *together with draft legislation* to the legislature in the manner *required*
10 provided under section 13.172 (2) of the statutes by August 1, 2002. If legislation *to*
11 substantially identical to that prepared by the joint legislative council is not enacted *the*
recommendations

Representative Carpenter:

Article IV, Sections 1 and 17^v of the Wisconsin Constitution collectively specify that all legislative power is vested in the legislature and that a law may only be enacted by bill. In order to avoid any argument that this amendment violates these provisions, we have drafted the amendment to potentially require a "referendum on enactment" of the legislation developed under the amendment, rather than a binding referendum. Please let us know if you desire any changes to the amendment or have any questions.
