2	1. Page 282, line 8: after that line insert:
3	"SECTION 874r. 947.0125 (4) of the statutes is created to read:
4	947.0125 (4) Whoever posts or displays a message on a computerized
5	communication system under any of the following circumstances, if the message
6	includes information on how to contact the individual who is the subject of the
7	message, is guilty of a Class I felony:
8	(a) The message invites another to harass the individual and the person who
9	posts or displays the message intends that another harass the individual.
10	(b) The message invites another to send mail or a message to the individual or
11	make a telephone call to the individual and use obscene, lewd, or profane language,
12	or suggest any lewd or lascivious act in the mail, message, or telephone call, and the

person who posts or displays the message intends that another send mail or a
message to the individual or make a telephone call to the individual using obscene,

3 lewd, or profane language or suggesting any lewd or lascivious act.".
