1 **AN ACT to repeal 77.54 (15); and to amend 77.54 (2m) and 287.31 (1) (a) of the**
2 **statutes; relating to: repealing the sales tax and use tax exemption for**
3 **newspapers, periodicals, and shoppers guides.**

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill repeals the sales tax and use tax exemption on the sale and use of newspapers, periodicals, and shoppers guides.

For further information see the *state and local* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

4 **SECTION 77.54 (2m) of the statutes is amended to read:**
5 **77.54 (2m)** The gross receipts from the sales of and the storage, use or other
6 consumption of tangible personal property or services that become an ingredient or
7 component of shoppers guides, newspapers or periodicals or that are consumed or
8 lose their identity in the manufacture of shoppers guides, newspapers or periodicals,

1 whether or not the shoppers guides, newspapers or periodicals are transferred
2 without charge to the recipient. In this subsection, "shoppers guides", "newspapers"
3 and "periodicals" have the meanings under sub. (15), 1999 stats. The exemption
4 under this subdivision does not apply to advertising supplements that are not
5 newspapers.

6 SECTION 2. 77.54 (15) of the statutes is repealed.

7 SECTION 3. 287.31 (1) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:

8 287.31 (1) (a) "Newspaper" means a publication that is printed on newsprint
9 and that is published, printed and distributed in this state, at daily, weekly or other
10 short, periodic intervals, for the dissemination of current news and information of
11 a general character and of a general interest to the public. "Newspaper" also includes
12 any "shoppers guide", as defined in s. 77.54 (15), 1999 stats., that is printed on
13 newsprint.

14 SECTION 4. ~~Effective date~~

15 (1) ~~This act~~ takes effect on the first day of the 2nd month beginning after
16 publication.
