ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 57,
TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,
TO ASSEMBLY BILL 1

March 14, 2002 – Offered by Representatives LASSA, PLALE, STASKUNAS, STEINBRINK,
SHILLING, MORRIS-TATUM and COGGS.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 **1.** Page 352, line 12: after that line insert:

3 “(9c) GOVERNOR’S BLUE RIBBON TASK FORCE ON STATE GOVERNMENTAL EFFICIENCY.

4 (a) There is created a special committee to be called the Governor’s Blue Ribbon
5 Task Force on State Governmental Efficiency, which shall consist of members
6 appointed by the governor.

7 (b) The governor shall appoint or determine the method of selection of the
8 officers of the task force and shall call the first meeting of the task force.

9 (c) The department of administration shall provide necessary administrative
10 support services to the task force.

11 (d) The department of administration shall reimburse members of the task
12 force for their actual and necessary expenses incurred in carrying out their functions

1 from the appropriation under section 20.505 (4) (ba) of the statutes, within the
2 budget of the task force authorized under section 16.40 (14) of the statutes.

3 (e) The task force shall identify overlapping or duplicative services or job duties
4 in and between state agencies and recommend appropriate changes to maximize
5 state governmental efficiency.

6 (f) The task force shall report its findings and recommendations to the
7 governor, and to the legislature in the manner provided in section 13.172 (2) of the
8 statutes, no later than January 6, 2003. Upon submittal of its report, the task force
9 ceases to exist.”.
