Require that the Board, in establishing the program, define what constitutes a state or federal discretionary grant for which a matching fund loan may be requested and establish the new loan program within 90 days of the effective date of the bill. Provide that in creating the new program the Board shall ensure that loans under the program may not be for a period exceeding five years and that no such loan may be extended by the Board beyond the original period of the loan. Require that the Board report to the Governor, the Joint Committee on Finance and the Secretary of Administration on the proposed structure and operation of the loan program no later than 30 days after establishing the program and before actual implementation of the program.

**Governor:** Reduce the Board's general operations appropriation by \$27,400 in 2001-02 and \$39,100 in 2002-03. These amounts represent 3.5% of the appropriation in 2001-02 and 5.0% in 2002-03.

**Joint Finance:** Reduce the Board's general operations appropriation by an additional \$7,800 in 2002-03. This amount represents an additional 1% reduction in the Board's state operations appropriations in 2002-03.

**Assembly:** Reduce the Board's GPR state operations appropriation by an additional \$3,900 in 2002-03. This amount represents an additional 0.5% reduction in the Board's state operations appropriations in 2002-03.
