2 **1.** Page 11, line 9: after that line insert:

3 "SECTION 20r. 16.705 (2m) of the statutes is created to read:

4 16.705 (2m) The department shall review each proposed contract for  
5 contractual services that provides for expenditure of more than \$150,000 or which  
6 the department estimates will result in expenditure of more than \$150,000 to  
7 determine whether the expenditures to be made under the contract will be efficient  
8 and cost-effective. The secretary shall file a report with the cochairpersons of the  
9 joint committee on finance no later than March 1 of each odd-numbered year  
10 concerning its determinations issued during the biennium ending on the preceding  
11 December 31."

CAUCUS SENATE AMENDMENT ,

TO SENATE SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,

TO ASSEMBLY BILL 1

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6 the department estimates will result in expenditure of more than \$150,000 to

1 concerning its determinations issued during the biennium ending on the preceding  
2 December 31.”.

3 **SECTION 20t.** 16.71 (1) of the statutes, as affected by 2001 Wisconsin Act 16, is  
4 amended to read:

5 16.71 (1) Except as otherwise required under this section and s. 16.78 or as  
6 authorized in s. 16.74, the department shall purchase and may delegate to special  
7 designated agents the authority to purchase all necessary materials, supplies,  
8 equipment, all other permanent personal property and miscellaneous capital, and  
9 contractual services and all other expense of a consumable nature for all agencies.  
10 In making any delegation, the department shall require the agent to adhere to all  
11 requirements imposed upon the department in making purchases under this  
12 subchapter. No delegation has the effect of exempting any proposed contract for  
13 contractual services from review under s. 16.705. All materials, services and other  
14 things and expense furnished to any agency and interest paid under s. 16.528 shall  
15 be charged to the proper appropriation of the agency to which furnished.”.

16 **2.** Page 434, line 12: after that line insert:

17 “(1c) REVIEW OF PROPOSED CONTRACTUAL SERVICE CONTRACTS. The treatment of  
18 sections 16.705 (2m) and 16.71 (1) of the statutes first applies with respect to  
19 contracts for contractual services entered into on the effective date of this  
20 subsection.”.
