7 summary under s. 20.005 (1) for that fiscal year to exceed the sum of the amount of
8 moneys designated as "Taxes" and "Departmental Revenues" in the summary under
9 s. 20.005 (1) for that fiscal year."

Terry Rhodes:

1. I drafted the titles in this provision to be consistent with those in the 1999 Wisconsin Statutes and not 2001 Wisconsin Act 16. When the final version of the schedule is printed for the 2001–03 biennium, the titles in the schedule will need to be changed back to the titles as they appeared in past versions of the schedule. (This is necessary not only for the provisions in this draft, but also for the operation of certain provisions contained in 2001 Wisconsin Act 16.)

2. As we briefly discussed, the legislature may not limit or diminish the constitutional authority of the governor to sign bills into law. In exercising his or her constitutional authority to sign bills into law, the governor is subject only to restrictions contained in the Wisconsin Constitution. ✓ For the purpose of this draft, therefore, I have not included the restriction on the governor's authority. Is this OK?
