The project may teach parenting skills to parents of children in preschool programs and early elementary grades, establish a family resource center or develop and implement a plan to increase family involvement in education. The bill appropriates \$500,000 GPR annually for local grants and \$58,000 GPR for state operations and 1.0 FTE in 2001-02 (\$68,500 GPR in 2002-03). The bill would also require a 20 pecent match from grant recipients. School districts would incur new costs for these programs, but these costs would be fully or partially offset by the state grants. Since this bill designates these grants as counting toward the state's two-thirds funding commitment, the state could reduce

Since this bill designates these grants as counting toward the state's two-thirds funding commitment, the state could reduce \$166,700 GPR annually from general equalization aids to adjust overall state funding related to maintaining this commitment. Under the two-thirds sharing arrangement, local property taxes would increase by \$166,700.
