48.60 (2) (b) A bona fide educational institution whose pupils, in the ordinary course of events, return annually to the homes of their parents or guardians for not less than 2 ~~months~~ ^{weeks} of summer vacation.

Under current law, an institution may be classified as a private school if it meets certain specified criteria. Among other requirements the institution must be licensed by the state or the pupils must return ~~annually~~ to the homes of their parents or guardians for not less than two months of summer vacation each year.

(MPL) This bill allows an institution to be classified as a private school if the pupils ~~on the institution~~ return to the homes of their parents or guardians for not less than two weeks of summer vacation each year.
