Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The department could not obtain any data on police and fire commission action which would help to quantify the effects of this bill. Based on the information available to our department, it appears that this proposal has an indeterminate effect.

In some cases, PFCs handle suspensions which are also being investigated criminally by local law enforcement. In those cases, the timeline may prohibit the police and fire commission from relying on this active criminal investigation for assistance in their own dispositions. This would require that PFCs would be forced to conduct their own investigations and hold additional hearings.

In some cases, absent the existence of criminal investigations, the timeline may force the commissions to act quicker and may save legal costs for the municipality.

These two different scenarios could produce offsetting results and would vary by municipality.
