. Proposed s. 11.12 (7) (a) requires candidates who do not accept grants to file 24–hour reports of certain contributions received after certain thresholds are reached. In 1999 SB–113 and SSA 1 to SB–113, these reports were triggered when aggregate contributions from political party committees and from individuals exceeded specified levels. The reported contributions then trigger a state match to candidates who accept grants. Because candidates who do not accept grants are free to accept contributions from political action committees, it seemed to us that you would want to match those contributions also. Therefore, this draft accomplishes that. If this is not your intent, please let us know.
