

**SENATE SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,  
TO 2001 SENATE BILL 120**

May 30, 2001 – Offered by COMMITTEE ON EDUCATION.

1     **AN ACT** *to create* 121.91 (4) (i) of the statutes; **relating to:** increasing a school  
2         district’s revenue limit by the amount spent for school safety and security  
3         measures and granting rule-making authority.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

4         **SECTION 1.** 121.91 (4) (i) of the statutes is created to read:  
5         121.91 **(4)** (i) The limit otherwise applicable to a school district’s revenue under  
6         sub. (2m) in any school year is increased by an amount equal to the amount spent by  
7         the school district in that school year for safety measures designed to protect pupils  
8         and staff and for security measures designed to prevent criminal activity in schools,  
9         as determined by the state superintendent, but not more than an amount equal to  
10        \$100 multiplied by the number of pupils enrolled. The state superintendent shall  
11        promulgate rules specifying the safety and security measures that are eligible for a  
12        revenue limit adjustment under this paragraph.

**SECTION 2. Initial applicability.**

(1) This act first applies to the calculation of a school district's revenue limit for the school year beginning after the effective date of this subsection.
