## Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

SB 128 will have no fiscal impact on the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission.

To the extent existing health insurance policies do not presently cover the contraceptive articles and services covered by SB 128, the mandated addition of this benefit will increase the insurance costs of state and local governments if all other existing benefits are maintained.

The Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission has no basis for determining the level of increased costs.
