Would you prefer to authorize the register in probate to waive the fee, rather than requiring a judge to hear the matter? Another option would be to authorize a court commissioner to waive the fee. Under current law, a probate judge may (but would not necessarily) assign such a matter to a court commissioner under s. 757.69 (1) (e) or 757.72 (2).
