Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law provides that the governor must appoint one student member to the board of regents of the University of Wisconsin (UW) System and that the governor may select this student member from recommendations made by elected representatives of student governments at institutions within the UW System. This bill requires the governor to appoint two student members, one of whom must be an undergraduate student who is at least 24 years old and represents the views of nontraditional students, such as those who are employed or who are parents.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:
