Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

SB 189 reclassifies state employees assigned as security officers at facilities owned, leased or operated by the UW Hospitals and Clinics Authority as protective occupation participants under the WRS. As a result, those eligible employees would have their WRS retirement benefits increase as the formula factor used to generate their retirement annuities would change. There are currently 16 eligible employees.

The estimated costs to the Department for implementing SB 189 would be negligible.

This fiscal estimate addresses only the administrative costs of SB 189. The Joint Survey Committee on Retirement Systems will estimate the fiscal effect on the trust fund.
