## 7001 **1999 BILL**

1	AN ACT to amend 118.019 (2) (intro.); and to create 118.019 (2m) of the statutes;
2	relating to: requiring school boards that provide instruction in human
3	sexuality and related subjects to provide instruction in early childhood brain
4	research and development.

#### Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law permits a school board to provide instruction in human sexuality, reproduction, family planning, human immunodeficiency virus and acquired immunodeficiency syndrome, prenatal development, childbirth, adoption, available prenatal and postnatal support, and male responsibility. This bill provides that if a school board offers instruction in any of these subjects, it must also offer instruction in early childhood brain research and development.
