1 **AN ACT** *to create* 71.05 (6) (b) 34. of the statutes; **relating to:** creating an
 2 individual income tax exemption for pay received from the federal government
 3 by members of a reserve component of the armed forces participating in
 4 Operation Enduring Freedom.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill creates an individual income tax exemption for pay received from the federal government by a member of a reserve component of the armed forces participating in Operation Enduring Freedom. The exemption applies to a member of a reserve component of the armed forces who is activated for Operation Enduring Freedom, and applies to any amount of military pay received by the person from the federal government.

This bill will be referred to the joint survey committee on tax exemptions for a detailed analysis, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

5 **SECTION 1.** 71.05 (6) (b) 34. of the statutes is created to read:
