AN ACT ...; relating to: passive alcohol sensors.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, a person may not operate a motor vehicle, a snowmobile, an all—terrain vehicle while under the influence of an intoxicant or with a blood or breath alcohol concentration in excess of a certain level. This bill prohibits a law enforcement officer from using a passive alcohol sensor for the purpose of detecting alcohol in a person's breath unless the person consents to its use. The bill defines "passive alcohol sensor" as a device that is used to determine the presence of alcohol in the air but that does not require a person to breathe directly into it through a mouthpiece, tube, or similar device.
