Senator Breske:

This version is identical to the previous version, except for the following:

- 1. The definition of the "practice of animal chiropractic" is revised.
- 2. Proposed s. 453.05 (2) (i) is created.
- 3. The rules that the examining board must promulgate are subject to a submission deadline and may be promulgated as emergency rules before the permanent rules go into effect.

Finally, in preparing this version, I realized that the examining board is not specifically authorized to require an applicant for a certificate to complete an examination. Arguably, the examining board could impose such a requirement by rule, because the examining board must promulgate rules establishing education, training, and competency requirements. Therefore, one could argue that the examining board could require an examination as a means of determining competency. However, depending on your intent, you might want to revise the bill to clarify whether the examining board has the authority to require an examination.
