## **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

This bill authorizes Milwaukee county to create a Milwaukee County child welfare district as a special purpose district that is seperate and distinct from the state and from Milwaukee county. The bill requires that district employees participate in the Milwaukee county retirement system. The bill has no tiscal effect on the Wisconsin retirement system. If a Milwaukee County child welfare district is created, the district would make payments to the Milwaukee retirement system for employee retirement benefits, but the amount of the payments would depend on number of person hired, the amount of salary paid those persons and any unfunded liability incurred by the district.
