

## 2001 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 8

January 23, 2001 – Introduced by Senator DECKER. Referred to Committee on Senate Organization.

1     **Relating to:** the life and public service of William Clayton Hicks.

2             Whereas, William Clayton Hicks was born on June 17, 1919, in Phillips,  
3     Wisconsin, and died on June 9, 1999, in Montgomery, Texas; and

4             Whereas, he graduated from the University of Wisconsin–Madison with a B.A.  
5     degree in 1940 and later studied at Harvard Business School in Cambridge,  
6     Massachusetts; and

7             Whereas, he served as a commissioned officer in the U.S. Army from 1942 to  
8     1946 and subsequently in the U.S. Army Reserve, and was a member of the American  
9     Legion and the Veterans of Foreign Wars; and

10            Whereas, he married Betty Flood in Wisconsin on August 25, 1943, and settled  
11    in Phillips, Wisconsin, after WW II; and

12            Whereas, he was elected county clerk in Price County in 1946; and

13            Whereas, he was elected to the State Senate in 1948 and served the Twelfth  
14    Senate District that included Ashland, Iron, Price, Rusk, Sawyer, and Vilas Counties  
15    from 1949 to 1953; and
