1 **Relating to:** the life and public service of William Clayton Hicks.

2 Whereas, William Clayton Hicks was born on June 17, 1919, in Phillips,
3 Wisconsin, and died on June 9, 1999, in Montgomery, Texas; and

4 Whereas, he graduated from the University of Wisconsin-Madison with a B.A.
5 degree in 1940 and later studied at Harvard Business School in Cambridge,
6 Massachusetts; and

7 Whereas, he served as a commissioned officer in the U.S. Army from 1942 to
8 1946 and subsequently in the U.S. Army Reserve, and was a member of the American
9 Legion and the Veterans of Foreign Wars; and

10 Whereas, he married Betty Flood in Wisconsin on August 25, 1943, and settled
11 in Phillips, Wisconsin, after WW II; and

12 Whereas, he was elected county clerk in Price County in 1946; and

13 Whereas, he was elected to the State Senate in 1948 and served the Twelfth
14 Senate District that included Ashland, Iron, Price, Rusk, Sawyer and Vilas Counties
15 from 1949 to 1953; and

1 Whereas, he served on the Senate Committees on Education and Public Welfare
2 and Veterans' Affairs and his legislative career exhibited an interest in local
3 government affairs and veterans; and

4 Whereas, he retired as Vice President and Corporate Comptroller after 28 years
5 of employment with Sears, Roebuck and Co. at the national headquarters in Chicago,
6 Illinois, and subsequently moved to Texas in 1987; now, therefore, be it

7 ***Resolved by the senate, the assembly concurring, That*** the members of the
8 Wisconsin legislature commend the devoted public service William Clayton Hicks
9 gave to this state, express their sorrow at his death and extend condolences to his
10 family and friends; and, be it further
