

## 2001 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 10

January 25, 2001 – Introduced by Senators GEORGE, BRESKE, RISSER, GROBSCHMIDT and DARLING, cosponsored by Representatives YOUNG, LASSA, SCHNEIDER, RYBA, WILLIAMS and MILLER. Referred to Committee on Senate Organization.

1     **Relating to:** the life and public service of Richard J. Zaborski.

2             Whereas, Richard J. Zaborski was born on January 7, 1927, and died January  
3     9, 2001; and

4             Whereas, Richard J. Zaborski showed an early flair for leadership at St. Mary  
5     of Czestochowa grade school and Messmer High School in Milwaukee, being elected  
6     president of various organizations and societies; and

7             Whereas, he demonstrated further leadership in volunteering for service in the  
8     United States Army on his 18th birthday, where he was commissioned as a  
9     lieutenant; and

10            Whereas, in 1950, he again answered his country's call, serving as a combat  
11     infantry officer in Korea, and was awarded the Purple Heart and the Bronze Star for  
12     valor; and

13            Whereas, after the war, he attended Marquette University, receiving his B.S.  
14     degree in 1953; and
