Relating to: urging the Wisconsin congressional delegation to work to enact legislation that would remove social security numbers from hunting and fishing license applications.

Whereas, in 1996 Congress passed, and the President signed, the Personal Responsibility and Work Opportunity Reconciliation Act of 1996 (PRWORA); and

Whereas, PRWORA contained numerous provisions geared toward strengthening state laws relating to child support enforcement and paternity establishment; and

Whereas, PRWORA, among other things, requires states to implement procedures under which the state has the authority to withhold, suspend or restrict the use of driver's licenses, professional and occupational licenses and recreational licenses, including hunting and fishing licenses, of individuals owing past—due support or failing, after receiving appropriate notice, to comply with subpoenas or warrants relating to paternity or child support proceedings; and


