


2001 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION

1 **Relating to:** the life and public service of Jane Pettit.

2 Whereas, Jane Pettit passed away on September 10, 2001, after a courageous,
3 year[^] long battle against lung cancer; and

4 Whereas, although Jane Pettit has passed, her remarkable life, courageous
5 spirit, and philanthropic generosity will be an inspiration for the entire State of
6 Wisconsin for generations to come; and

7 Whereas, the Pettit name has become synonymous with compassion and
8 kindness thanks to years of charitable acts by Jane Pettit; and

9 Whereas, Jane Pettit's generosity and greatness can be seen when reviewing
10 her extraordinary legacy; and

11 Whereas, Jane Pettit endowed a floor at the Children's Hospital of Wisconsin
12 in 1987; and

13 Whereas, Jane Pettit's generosity led to the construction and opening of the
14 Bradley Center in Milwaukee in 1988; and

1 Whereas, Jane Pettit provided funding for the neonatal care unit at St.
2 Joseph’s Hospital in 1991; and

3 Whereas, Jane Pettit’s donation to the Pettit National Ice Center in West Allis
4 has provided the United States Olympic Speed Skating team with a world renowned
5 training facility, and has given residents of the Milwaukee area a first class skating
6 facility available for public use; and

7 Whereas, Jane Pettit made numerous donations to the Milwaukee Arts
8 Museum, including the purchase of several paintings by internationally acclaimed
9 artist Georgia O’Keefe in 1997, and contributions to the building campaign that
10 assisted in the construction of the museum’s recently opened Calatrava addition;
11 and

12 Whereas, Jane Pettit’s ongoing support for the Great Circus Parade helped
13 keep this Wisconsin tradition a success; and

14 Whereas, Jane Pettit became a part owner of the Milwaukee Brewers in 1999,
15 continuing a tradition of local ownership of Wisconsin’s major league baseball team;
16 and

17 Whereas, Jane Pettit in ^{the year} 2000 supported Alverno College, Mount Mary College,
18 Messmer High School, the Schlitz Audubon Center, Boerner Botanical Gardens, the
19 proposed African American World Cultural Center, and the Wisconsin AIDS fund;
20 and

21 Whereas, Jane Pettit’s donation of ~~\$20 million~~ ^{\$20,000,000} led to the construction of the
22 Lynde and Harry Bradley School of Technology and Trade in Milwaukee; and

23 Whereas, Jane Pettit devoted her life to philanthropy, the arts, and improving
24 the quality of life in Milwaukee and throughout Wisconsin; and

1 Whereas, Jane Pettit's generosity leaves a long and proud legacy that will not
2 be forgotten by those whose lives she has touched; now, therefore, be it ✓

3 **Resolved by the senate, the assembly concurring, That** the members of the ✓
4 Wisconsin legislature commend Jane Pettit for her philanthropy, ^{her} generosity towards ↗
5 the arts, and her efforts to improve the quality of life in Milwaukee and throughout
6 Wisconsin; express their sorrow at her death; and extend condolences to her family
7 and friends; and, be it further ✓
