

2001 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 49

October 23, 2001 – Introduced by Senators DARLING, ROSENZWEIG and WELCH, cosponsored by Representatives JESKEWITZ, J. LEHMAN, HAHN, OWENS, NASS, RYBA, URBAN, RILEY, GUNDRUM, OTT, GUNDERSON and STONE.

1 **Relating to:** the life and public service of Nile W. Soik.

2 Whereas, Nile W. Soik was born on May 2, 1923, in Milwaukee, Wisconsin, and
3 died on August 3, 2001, in Whitefish Bay; and

4 Whereas, he graduated from Riverside High School; received a B.S. degree in
5 engineering from the U.S. Military Academy at West Point in 1945, graduating in the
6 top 10% of his class; and earned an M.B.A. degree from the University of Wisconsin
7 in 1951, and a Ph.D. degree from Cornell University in Ithaca, New York; and

8 Whereas, he served in the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers in the Philippines; and

9 Whereas, he worked as a trainer in the human resources department at
10 Allen-Bradley Company and taught courses at Marquette University, Milwaukee
11 School of Engineering, Lakeland College, Milwaukee Technical College, and
12 Cardinal Stritch University; and

13 Whereas, he was elected to the assembly in 1960 and served from 1961 to 1969,
14 and then was elected to the senate in 1968 and served from 1969 to 1973; and
