Whereas, he worked as a trainer in the human resources department at Allen-Bradley Co and taught courses at Marquette University, Milwaukee School of Engineering, Lakeland College, Milwaukee Technical College, and Cardinal

Whereas, he was elected to the assembly in 1960 and served from 1961 to 1969
