

# 2001 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION

7 ( Day)

Relating to: urging the Minnesota Legislature to continue the income tax (1)reciprocity agreement between Minnesota and Wisconsin. 3 Whereas, the income tax reciprocity agreement between Wisconsin and Minnesota is designed to simplify the income tax filing process for taxpayers who live 4 5 in one state and work in the other; and Whereas, Wisconsin currently has income tax reciprocity agreements with 6 Illinois, Michigan, Indiana, and Kentucky, as well as Minnesota; and 7 Whereas, Wisconsin's long-standing income tax reciprocity agreement with Minnesota has been in place for 34 years, having originally been enacted in 1968; and Whereas, the Covernor of Minnesota has proposed ending the reciprocity (10)11 agreement with Wisconsin; and 12 Whereas, the reciprocity agreement has been a tremendous convenience for residents in both Wisconsin and Minnesota, allowing those affected taxpayers to file 13

one income tax return instead of one income tax return for each state; and
