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2001-2003 Statutory Language Proposals

Division: CUSTOMER ASSISTANCE AND EXTERNAL RELATIONS

Bureau: COMMUNITY FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

Issue/Topic: INTENT TO APPLY LANGUAGE

Proposed Change: Eliminate the requirement to submit a new notice for financial assistance under the safe drinking water loan program if a local government unit does not apply by April 30 of the 2nd year following the year in which it submitted its notice.

Eliminate s. 281.61(3)(b).

~~(b) If a local government unit does not apply for financial assistance by April 30 of the 2nd year following the year in which it submitted notice under par. (a), the local governmental unit shall submit a new notice under par. (a).~~

Explanatory Note: All three loan programs in the Environmental Improvement Fund (EIF) have statutory language which require potential loan applicants to submit an Intent to Apply (ITA) form. The language for the Clean Water Fund Program and the Land Recycling Program are identical, and only require that the ITA be submitted at least 6 months before the beginning of the fiscal year. The administrative codes for both programs establish the period of time during which the ITA is effective.

The statutory language for the Safe Drinking Water Program states that the ITA is effective through April 30 of the second year following the year in which the ITA was submitted. This creates an ITA period that is inconsistent with the other programs and does not allow flexibility to change the ITA period via administrative code.

Currently, under the safe drinking water loan program, this state provides loans to local governmental units for projects for the construction or modification of public water systems. Before a local governmental unit applies for a safe drinking water loan, it is required to submit a notice of intent to apply. Under current law, if a local governmental unit does not apply for a loan by April 30 of the second year following the year in which it submitted the notice of intent to apply, the local governmental unit must submit a new notice of intent to apply. This bill eliminates the requirement that a local governmental unit submit a new notice of intent to apply for a safe drinking water loan if the local governmental unit does not apply for a loan by April 30 of the second year following the year in which it submitted its original notice of intent to apply.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

1 **SECTION 1.** 281.61 (3) (b)^X of the statutes is repealed.

2 **SECTION 2.** 281.61 (3) (c)^X of the statutes is amended to read:

3 281.61 (3) (c) The department may waive par. (a) ~~or~~ (b)[✓] upon the written request
4 of a local governmental unit.
