Issue/Topic: GREAT LAKES DREDGING

Proposed Change: Add dredging on the Great Lakes as a project eligible for funding under the Recreational Boating Facilities program.

s. 30.92(4)(b)8.a.  
a. A project for the dredging of a channel in a waterway to the degree that is necessary to accommodate recreational watercraft ~~if the project is for an inland water.~~

Explanatory Note: Presently the Wisconsin Waterways Commission is not able to fund channel dredging in either Lake Michigan or Lake Superior because it is an eligible cost only to inland sponsors. The low water level in Lake Michigan has called attention to this program deficiency. Any new projects approved under this expanded eligibility will be accommodated within the funding appropriated by the Legislature. The Commission has requested that the Department pursue this language change.

Under current law, DNR, with approval from the Wisconsin waterways commission, administers a financial assistance program for expenses relating to construction and maintenance of recreational boating facilities, locks or other facilities that provide access between waterways (facilities). Among the projects that qualify for funds under the program is a project for the dredging of a channel in a waterway to the degree that is necessary to accommodate recreational watercraft, provided that the project is for an inland water. This bill eliminates the requirement that such a project must be for an inland water before it may qualify to receive recreational boating aid funding.

For further information see the *state and local* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.
