

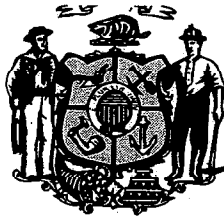

Brief Description of Intent:

Transfer an Employment Specialist from the Division of Vocational Rehabilitation to Risk Management. This employe is currently assigned to Risk Management under an interchange agreement with DVR. DVR received position authority 18 years ago to provide rehabilitation services to injured state employes under the Worker's Compensation law. Due to recent federal mandates, DVR has requested Risk Management absorb this program as federal mandates conflict with Worker's Compensation law.

Currently, one full-time position is authorized for DWD to provide rehabilitation services under the worker's compensation law to injured state employees. This bill transfers that position and the incumbent employee holding that position from DWD to DOA. The bill also provides that the transferred employee shall have all the same rights and the same status in DOA that the employee enjoyed in DWD and that, if the employee has attained permanent status in class, the employee is not required to serve a probationary period.
