**Brief Description of Intent:**

Transfer an electrician position from DWD to the Division of Buildings and Police Services. The position does work for DWD in the GEF 1 building, but with major remodeling completed, there is less need for DWD to institute small projects requiring the services of a full-time electrician. The transfer will allow all trades work in the building to be under the direct supervision of the Complex Manger rather than the tenant agencies.
