Brief Description of Intent:

Transfer of police services from State Fair Park to the Division of Buildings and Police Services. This will likely include 6.0 permanent FTE and a considerable amount of LTE expense. DOA has extensive experience with police operations in both the Madison and Milwaukee areas. The joining of State Fair Park police with the Milwaukee contingent of Capitol Police should improve the level of professional response in the SE metropolitan area for state facilities. It is assumed that DOA will charge State Fair Park for all police services provided.

This bill transfers the positions of the state fair park police, and incumbents in those positions, from the state fair park board to DOA.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

2 SECTION 1. 230.36 (1m) (b) 2. (intro.) of the statutes is amended to read:
3 230.36 (1m) (b) 2. (intro.) A conservation warden, conservation patrol boat
4 captain, conservation patrol boat engineer, member of the state patrol, state motor
5 vehicle inspector, University of Wisconsin System police officer, security officer, or
6 security person, ~~state fair park police officer~~, special tax agent, excise tax
7 investigator employed by the department of revenue, and special criminal
8 investigation agent employed by the department of justice at all times while:

2 SECTION 9146. Nonstatutory provisions; state fair park board.

3 (1) STATE FAIR PARK POLICE SERVICES.

4 (a) On the effective date of this ^{auto ref. "KA"} ~~subdivision~~ ^{paragraph}, all full-time equivalent positions
5 in the state fair park board having duties primarily related to the state fair park
6 police and the incumbents in those positions, as determined by the secretary of
7 administration, are transferred to the department of administration.

8 (b) Employees transferred under paragraph ~~(a)~~ ^{(a) auto ref. "KA"} have all the rights and the same
9 status under subchapter V of chapter 111 and chapter 230 of the statutes in the
10 department of administration that they enjoyed in the state fair park board
11 immediately before the transfer. Notwithstanding section 230.28 (4) of the statutes,
12 no employee so transferred who has attained permanent status in class is required
13 to serve a probationary period.
