


## HIV/AIDS Appropriation

### Current Language

S.20.435 (5) (am) and s.252.12 govern funding and provision of services relating to acquired immunodeficiency syndrome (HIV/AIDS)

### Proposed Change

Amend s.252.12 to allow payment under s.20.4<sup>3</sup>5 (5)(am) for hepatitis C testing and prevention services for individuals who have or are at risk for HIV/AIDS.

### Effect of the Change

In addition to the current services provided for individuals at risk for HIV/AIDS, the Department would be able to offer this population services related to the prevention of the hepatitis C virus infection.

### Rationale for the Change

Approximately 40% of HIV infected persons in the US are estimated to be co-infected with hepatitis C (HCV). HCV infection has been associated with increased morbidity and mortality in individuals affected with HIV and HIV infection appears to affect the course of HCV infection, sometimes causing accelerated progression to liver disease and cirrhosis. In addition, HCV-related liver disease may limit tolerance to many HIV medications.

The Department proposes to use state funds to provide hepatitis C services to individuals who have or are at risk for HIV/AIDS. Current statutory language limits the use of state funding for services specifically enumerated in s.252.12. By amending statutory language to expand the services available under this section to include hepatitis C services, as they relate to individuals with or at risk of HIV/AIDS, the Department would be able to offer these services.

Hi Debora.

Our program staff have reviewed your draft of this language and we have a few comments. Most of them are just language preferences relating to how we refer to AIDS/HIV. I'll summarize here; I also have a marked-up copy of the draft with preferred language pencilled in. If you could send me your fax # I can send you this and you can decide whether the suggested changes are appropriate or not.

✓ 1. To answer your drafter's notes: The test performed for Hepatitis C should not be subject to the confidentiality requirements that tests for HIV are.

No, there is no intent to amend s.49.686, 252.16 or 252.17.

✓ 2. Rather than "acquired immunodeficiency syndrome," program staff indicate it is preferable to use the term "human immunodeficiency virus." Also, HIV should be substituted for AIDS where possible.

✓ 3. Add "virus infection" to any reference to Hepatitis C.

✓ 4. Don't amend s.252.12(2)(a)1. *From Sue Jablonsky - it should be amended*

✓ 5. Page 3, line 2 (s.252.12(2)(a)2.) should read "immunodeficiency virus or hepatitis C virus infection."

✓ 6. page 4, lines 3 and 4, remove "prevention and training" and add to the end of the sentence, so it reads "are responsible for human immunodeficiency virus and hepatitis C virus prevention and training."

✓ 7. Page 4, line 22, could you insert "or confidential" after "anonymous"? [confidential means the name is associated with the information but not released].

Thanks for all your work on this.
