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Milwaukee Child Welfare "Intercept"

Current Language

By statute (s.48.561(3)(a)), Milwaukee County is required to contribute annually \$58,893,500 towards the cost of the child protective services (CPS) program in Milwaukee beginning January 1, 1998 when the state assumed responsibility for child protective services in Milwaukee County.

S.46.40 sets the levels for Community Aids funding.

Proposed Change

Revise s.48.561(3)(a) to specify that \$38,792,200 of the total \$58,893,500 contribution is implemented through a reduction in Milwaukee county's Community Aids funding

Revise the Community Aids funding levels in s.46.40 to reflect the reduction in Milwaukee's Community Aids funding as follows:

--change the Basic County Allocation levels in s.46.40(2) to \$245,642,500 in 2001-02 and \$245,642,500 in 2002-03.

--change the Prevention and Treatment of Substance Abuse allocation in s. 46.40 (2m)(a) to \$9,735,600 in each fiscal year.

Effect of Change

The current mechanism of "intercepting" Milwaukee County's Community Aids revenue will be eliminated. Instead, the GPR and federal funding in Community Aids that would have been allocated to Milwaukee County will be reduced and the same amount of funding will be budgeted directly in the Milwaukee Child Welfare program budget appropriations.

Rationale for the Change

Since calendar year 1999, Milwaukee County has chosen to meet its statutory requirement in s. 48.561(3)(a) through a reduction of \$38,792,200 in Community Aids funding and a

reduction of \$20,101,300 in Shared Revenue funding. The \$58,893,500 Milwaukee County contribution is known as the Milwaukee Child Welfare "intercept".

The Community Aids intercept mechanism creates a significant amount of additional and unnecessary administrative work. DHFS program and accounting staff must initially issue the "full" Community Aids contract to Milwaukee County, then immediately (within the next week) issue a revised contract to Milwaukee at the reduced level. A portion of the Milwaukee-related Community Aids funding must be accounted for as GPR funding in the Community Aids program, then accounted for as a reduction in GPR funding in the Community Aids program, and also accounted for as PRS funding in the Milwaukee Child Welfare program.

The treatment of federal IV-E funding is especially convoluted. Federal IV-E funding is earned on the basis of the CPS activities performed in Milwaukee. However, DHFS staff must first allocate a portion of the Milwaukee-related IV-E funding as federal funding to the Community Aids program, then reduce the Community Aids contract as noted above, and allocate that same revenue (as PRS funding) back to the Milwaukee Child Welfare program. In addition to the increased workload, the multiple, complicated transactions increase the possibility for accounting errors. None of this accounting and administrative work provides any value-added to the program. The intercept mechanism also creates unnecessary confusion and complications during the biennial budgeting process.

Equally important, the intercept mechanism has a negative program effect in that it distorts the county funding allocations under Community Aids. Because the intercept is a fixed dollar amount and is included in the calculation of Milwaukee's county allocation, there is a disproportionate effect on Milwaukee whenever there is an increase or decrease in total Community Aids funding. For the same reason, the intercept system also distorts the county funding allocations to non-Milwaukee counties.

In its 01-03 biennial budget request, the Department is proposing the elimination of the current Milwaukee intercept mechanism for Community Aids. Instead, the GPR and federal funding in Community Aids will be reduced and the same amount of funding will be budgeted directly in the Milwaukee Child Welfare program budget appropriations. The initial Community Aids contract issued by DHFS to Milwaukee County will be at the reduced level. This eliminates the administrative and programmatic problems described above.

Specifically, the Paper specifies that \$38,792,200 of Milwaukee County's contribution for child welfare services is to be made through a reduction in Milwaukee County's community aids allocation, but if you add up the figures, you arrive at \$38,792,300. Specifically, the base level, basic county allocation (BCA) given in LRB 0-0443 is \$282,851,700 and the BCA, as affected by this draft, is \$245,642,500. Subtract the smaller figure from the larger and you get \$37,209,200. Similarly, the base level for the substance abuse prevention and treatment (SAPT) allocation is \$11,318,700 and the SAPT allocation, as affected by this draft, is \$9,735,600. Again, subtracting the smaller figure from the larger, you get \$1,583,100. Then, add \$37,209,200 and \$1,583,100 and you get \$38,792,300, which is \$100 over the desired figure.

Accordingly, please go over the figures and advise me from which figure the extra \$100 should be subtracted. Options include the BCA, the SAPT allocation, or the shared revenue deduction.

I think that if you redo the math you will find that the figures given in the DHFS Issue Paper are off by \$100. Specifically, the Issue Paper specifies that \$38,792,200 of Milwaukee County's contribution for child welfare services is to be made through a reduction in Milwaukee County's community aids allocation, but if you add up the figures you arrive at \$38,792,300. Specifically, the base-level, basic county allocation (BCA) given in 2001 LRB-0443 is \$282,851,700 and the BCA, as affected by this draft, is \$245,642,500. Subtract the smaller figure from the larger and you get \$37,209,200. Similarly, the base level for the substance abuse prevention and treatment (SAPT) allocation is \$11,318,700 and the SAPT allocation, as affected by this draft, is \$9,735,600. Again, subtracting the smaller figure from the larger, you get \$1,583,100. Then, add \$37,209,200 and \$1,583,100 and you get \$38,792,300, which is \$100 over the desired figure.

Accordingly, please go over the figures and advise me from which figure the extra \$100 should be subtracted. Options include the BCA, the SAPT allocation, or the shared revenue deduction.

Thank you for the opportunity to review LRB-0442/1. The following corrections should be made:

A. Correction in Basic County Allocation

- ✗ Lines 3, page 2 should be changed from \$245,642,500 to \$245,706,500 in fiscal year 2001-02;
- ✗ Lines 4 page 2 should be changed from \$245,642,500 to \$245,706,500 in fiscal year 2002-03.

Explanation: The original statutory language drafting instructions were based on a preliminary Community Aids worksheet which included some minor technical errors. The corrected amounts noted above are consistent with the final Community Aids worksheet which is the basis for the Department's September 15 budget request.

B. Correction in SAPT Allocation

- ✗ Line 8, page 2 should be changed from \$9,735,600 to \$9,735,700.

Explanation: The LRB drafter correctly identified an inconsistency in the original drafting instructions. This correction resolves that error consistent with the Department's September 15 budget request on Community Aids.

C. Correction in applicability of change

- ✗ Line 18, page 2 should be changed from "in fiscal year 2000-2001" to in each fiscal year.
- ✗ Line 21, page 2 should be changed from "in fiscal year 2000-2001" to in each fiscal year.
- Last sentence of bill analysis should be changed from "in fiscal year 2000-2001" to in each fiscal year.

Explanation: The elimination of the Milwaukee Community Aids Community Aids "intercept" mechanism is intended to be applicable in every fiscal year, on a permanent basis, effective fiscal year 2001-02 (the first year of the 01-03 biennial budget). This is consistent with the Department's

September budget request. In its budget request, in both fiscal years 2001-02 and 2002-03 the Department reduced the Community Aids appropriations and increased the Milwaukee child welfare appropriations by the same amounts to implement the elimination of the Community Aids intercept.
