Child Abuse and Neglect Prevention Board Drafting Request
To the Legislative Reference Bureau

Draft for 01-03 Budget Bill introduction.

In s. 20.433, consolidate the 2 segregated appropriations (q) and (r) into 20.433 (1) (q) and delete (r).

In s. 20.433, delete 20.433(1)(b), the annual general purpose revenue.


In Section 1199d, referring to 48.982 (2) (d) change language that reads "other than moneys received under s. 341.14 (6r) (b) 6" to read "and 50% of moneys received under s. 341.14 (6r) (b) 6".

Change language in the next sentence to read "Fifty per cent of the moneys received under s. 341.14 (6r) (b) 6 and interest earned on the remaining 50% of the moneys received under s. 341.14 (6r) (b) 6".

Also, in s. 20.433 (1) (q) change language from "other than moneys received under s. 341.14 (6r) (b) 6., and all interest earned on moneys received under s. 341.14 (6r) (b) 6" to read "50% of moneys received under s. 341.14 (6r) (b) 6 and all interest on the remaining 50% of moneys received under s. 341. (6r) (b) 6".

This language change represents the original intent by the Child Abuse and Neglect Prevention Board to generate additional program revenue through the sale of special license plates. The additional revenue will be used by the Child Abuse and Neglect Prevention Board in continued efforts to expand programming for the prevention of child abuse and neglect in the State of Wisconsin. In addition, revenues being used for programming can be counted to generate additional federal dollars through the Child Abuse Prevention and Treatment Act. Currently, money received from sale of the license plate cannot be used for draw of additional federal match dollars.

Under current law, the ~~Child Abuse and Neglect Prevention Board~~ (CANPB) may expend the interest earned on, but not the principal of, moneys received from the sale of "Celebrate Children" license plates to award grants to provide child abuse and neglect prevention programs, early childhood family education centers, and right from the start projects; to administer statewide child abuse and neglect prevention projects; and to pay for the operating costs of ~~the~~ CANPB. This bill permits ~~the~~ CANPB to expend 50% of the moneys received from the sale of those license plates, and all interest earned on the remaining 50% of those moneys received, to award those grants, administer those projects, and pay for those costs.

Current law contains an annual, sum certain appropriation of segregated revenues from the children's trust fund for the operating costs of ~~the~~ CANPB and for statewide projects to prevent child abuse and neglect, and a continuing appropriation, consisting of all moneys received for that fund, for grants to provide child abuse and neglect prevention programs, early childhood family education centers, and right from the start projects. This bill eliminates that annual, sum certain appropriation and folds its purposes into that continuing appropriation.

Current law also contains an appropriation from which ~~(73)~~ CANPB may expend general purpose revenues for early childhood family education center grants. This bill eliminates that appropriation.

Gretchen and Nadine:

On the advice of LRB General Counsel Peter J. Dykman, this redraft deletes "the remaining 50% of . . ." from ss. 20.433 (1) (q) and 48.982 (2) (d), as affected by the draft, so that the language relating to interest earned on moneys received from the sale of license plates will simply read "and all interest earned on the moneys received." That change will not affect the intent that the board be able to spend all interest earned on the moneys received from the sale of license plates and not expended and, indeed, will provide the board with greater flexibility in spending that interest earned. Specifically, General Counsel Dykman poses a scenario under which the board might spend less than 50% of the moneys received from the sale of license plates in a given year. In that case, more than 50% of the moneys received from the sale of license plates would be earning interest, and you would want to be able to spend the interest earned on *all* of that money and not be limited to spending the interest earned on only 50% of the moneys received from the sale of license plates.
