



Subject: 2001-03 BUDGET BILL

The Department of Justice requests that language be drafted for the 2001-03 budget bill, for the following purposes:

1. Handgun Hotline—We request an amendment to sec. 175.35(2i), stats., raising the fee from \$8 to \$16. This change is necessary to cover operating costs of the handgun hotline and to offset a portion of the deficit that has developed in this account in recent years.
2. Law Enforcement Training—We request language to ensure that payments under sec. 165.85(5)(b), stats., are not used to supplant existing funds and that the current commitment to the training effort at the local level is maintained. Under current law, sec. 165.85(4)(bn) requires that each law enforcement officer complete at least 24 hours of recertification training each fiscal year. Section 165.85(5)(b) requires that each law enforcement agency be reimbursed for approved expenses for completion of annual recertification training at a rate of at least \$160 per officer. The intent of the requested language is that these reimbursements are to be used at the local level only for reimbursement of approved expenses and not for other purposes.
3. Restrictions on Crime Victim Compensation—We request the repeal of sec. 949.06(5), to allow state and federal crime victim compensation funds to be used for the same purposes. Under current state law, certain benefits and any awards greater than \$10,000 can only be paid from federal funds. Because state and federal funds are received and depleted at different times, the depletion of one or the other fund creates three classes of victims—those fully paid, those only partially paid, and those receiving no payment until the designated funds are received in the next cycle. This is a self-imposed problem, in the sense that federal law does not have any such requirement, nor does any state other than Wisconsin impose a similar restriction on its crime victim compensation program.
4. Generic PR-S Appropriations—We request the creation of *generic* PR-S appropriations for our programs (2) and (5) in the Ch. 20 schedule. The current language under sec.

20.455(1)(km) and (3)(k) are examples of what is needed. Namely, language that is broad enough to allow us to receive and spend moneys from other state agencies for various purposes, including specific uses that have not yet been contemplated.

5. Change Some Annual Appropriations to Continuing—We request that certain PR *annual* appropriations be converted to *continuing*. Specifically, the appropriations under:

- (1)(gs)
- (1)(km)
- (2)(km)
- (3)(k)
- (5)(k)

These appropriations involve relatively small amounts of program revenues, and four of the five are PR-S, meaning that moneys from other agencies, rather than fees, are involved. Three of these appropriations have \$0 spending authority established in Ch. 20. Getting or modifying spending authority requires submitting requests under sec. 16.515, stats. Converting these accounts to *continuing* would mean that modifications to Ch. 20 could occur via WiSMART transactions approved by the Department of Administration.
