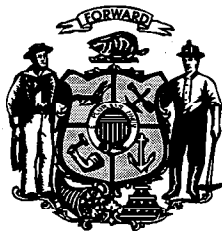

1. Defining theft of a leased or rented motor vehicle. Modify s. 943.20(1)(e) to specify that theft of a leased or rented motor vehicle occurs after the lease or rental agreement has expired (see attachment).

Thanks.

Amend s. 943.20 (1)(e) as follows:

Exempt from
(e) Intentionally fails to return any personal property which is in his or her possession or under his or her control by virtue of a written lease or written rental agreement, within 10 days after the lease or rental agreement has expired or in the case of a motor vehicle, after the lease or rental agreement has expired.
