Subject: Indian Gaming Statutory Language Request

I would like to request that statutory language be drafted to change the way in which unexpended revenues are handled for the appropriations that receive Indian Gaming revenues from s. 20.505(8)(hm). I believe there are a few options possible:

1. Make all of the individual appropriations that receive gaming revenues continuing appropriations instead of annual appropriations, as currently constructed.
2. Take out the language in the secondary appropriations stating that "All moneys transferred from the appropriation under this account under s. 20.505(8)(hm)(...) shall be credited to this account."
3. Make all unexpended revenues from the secondary appropriations revert back to the primary appropriation, 20.505(8)(hm).

The purpose for the proposed changes is to attempt to allow unexpended revenues from a previous fiscal year, which remain in each individual secondary appropriation under current law, be available for spending in subsequent fiscal years and biennia, if so authorized.

Now that I have had a chance to think about the request, I think the way to do it is to amend the language of each appropriation account by adding a sentence such as "Notwithstanding s. 20.001 (3) (a), the unencumbered balance on June 30 of each year shall revert to the appropriation under s. 20.505 (8) (hm)." I will also have to amend the language of 20.505 (8) (hm) so that the moneys that revert are also credited to the account.

Sounds good.

I have reviewed all of the appropriations that will be affected and most of them do not pose a problem. I do have a few questions:

1. Under s. 20.505 (8) (hm) 1f., \$2,500,000 is transferred to the conservation fund. Do you want the amount that is left over to revert back to (8) (hm)? **NO**. I'm not sure transferring the moneys back will work. If you intend the left over amounts to revert back, I will have to think some more about this one.

2. The appropriations under s. 20.235 (1) (k) and (km) are biennial appropriations. Do you want to change these to annuals so that each year the unencumbered balances revert back, or do you want the money to revert back at the end of the biennium? **We can keep these as biennials and revert the money back at the end of the biennium.**

This actually isn't a problem. KH 10/26/00

3. The appropriation under s. 20.143 (1) (kr) appropriates Indian gaming money but also money from another source. I don't think we can separate the moneys once they are commingled for purposes of transferring back the portion of unencumbered Indian gaming moneys. The same is true for the appropriation under s. 20.435 (4) (ky). I am assuming that you don't want the entire unencumbered balance of these appropriations (which include moneys other than Indian gaming moneys) to revert to 20.505 (8) (hm). We may need to restructure these if you want the unencumbered Indian gaming moneys to revert. **Good observation; let's leave these as they are and not revert them.**

No problem. I thought you were probably conferring with somebody. Rick Champagne drafted the provision last budget. He thought that perhaps the reason for drafting it the way it is now is that 1) the money wasn't supposed to revert back and 2) the interest is credited to the general fund (instead of under a SEG fund where the interest is credited to the fund). If #2 is still a concern, the SEG fund language can be drafted so that the interest is credited to the general fund instead of the SEG fund.

Those are my thoughts (and Rick's thoughts) on the subject. Let me know if you have any other questions.

Have you thought about creating a SEG fund instead of trying to work with the existing appropriation structure? If we created a SEG fund, then the moneys would automatically revert at the end of the fiscal year. If we keep the existing structure, each existing appropriation (and any new appropriations) will have to be amended to indicate the money must be transferred back. Either way, your intent is accomplished, but with the SEG fund, current drafting and future drafting will be much easier.

GAMBLING

The gaming compacts are regulated by the federal Indian Gaming Regulatory Act.

* Currently, the governor is authorized to enter into Indian gaming compacts with Indian tribes in this state. Under the ~~Indian~~ gaming compacts, ~~Indian~~ tribes are permitted to engage in certain forms of gambling activities on tribal lands. Pursuant to the compacts, the state receives moneys from the ~~Indian~~ tribes and from vendors who contract with the ~~Indian~~ tribes (Indian gaming receipts). The Indian gaming receipts are credited to an Indian gaming program revenue appropriation and are transferred annually to a variety of appropriation accounts to fund a variety of programs.

* This bill requires that, on June 30th of each year ^{annually} the unencumbered balances of the annual appropriations to which Indian gaming receipts are transferred, except the unencumbered balance of an appropriation to DHFS which appropriates moneys received by DHFS from other state agencies for aids to individuals and organizations, revert to the Indian gaming program revenue appropriation. In the case of the biennial appropriations to which Indian gaming receipts are transferred, on June 30th of each odd-numbered year any unencumbered balance reverts to the Indian gaming program revenue appropriation.

GAMBLING

Currently, the governor is authorized to enter into Indian gaming compacts with federally recognized American Indian tribes in this state. The gaming compacts are regulated by the federal Indian Gaming Regulatory Act. Under the gaming compacts, tribes are permitted to engage in certain forms of gambling activities on tribal lands. Pursuant to the compacts, the state receives moneys from the tribes and from vendors who contract with the tribes (Indian gaming receipts). The Indian gaming receipts are credited to an Indian gaming program revenue appropriation and are transferred annually to a variety of appropriation accounts to fund a variety of programs.

This bill requires that, on June 30 annually, the unencumbered balances of the annual appropriations to which Indian gaming receipts are transferred, except the unencumbered balance of an appropriation to DHFS which appropriates moneys received by DHFS from other state agencies for aids to individuals and organizations, revert to the Indian gaming program revenue appropriation. In the case of the biennial appropriations to which Indian gaming receipts are transferred, on June 30 of each odd-numbered year any unencumbered balance reverts to the Indian gaming program revenue appropriation.
