Issue/Topic: NONPOINT SOURCE BONDING

Proposed Change: The Department has requested an additional \$22,400,000 in bonding authority for nonpoint source water pollution abatement projects under s. 281.65. S. 20.866 (2) (te) should be amended to reflect this increase:

(te) *Natural resources; nonpoint source grants.* From the capital improvement fund, a sum sufficient for the department of natural resources to provide funds for nonpoint source water pollution abatement projects under s. 281.65. The state may contract public debt in an amount not to exceed ~~\$56,763,600~~ \$79,163,600 for this purpose.

Explanatory Note: This proposal would provide an additional \$22,400,000 for counties to pass on to landowners within priority watershed project areas to implement best management practices designed to limit or prevent nonpoint source pollution.

Desired Effective Date: The effective date of the budget.
