3. **Allow 100% Revenue Limit Carry-Over when Fund Balance is used to correct an Aid Computation Error.** Under current law, if a district fails to levy the full amount it is entitled to in a given year, it can carryover 75% of the unused revenue limit authority to the next year. Provide that any school district that uses its fund balance to replace lost school aid as a result of an error made in computing the district's general equalization aid payment can carryover 100% of its revenue limit authority.

4. **Clarify that State Computer Aid is Included in Shared Costs.** Clarify statutory language to include computer aid in the definition of shared costs. 121.07 (6)
