

As a result of internal and external discussions the Society's appropriation structure, we would like to request the Legislative Reference Bureau prepare a draft based on the attached proposal. The general framework for the proposed changes includes the following:

one subsection - "History Services"

1. The consolidation of five chapter 20 programs into one.
2. The merger of the existing (1a) and (1am) GPR general program operations appropriations for the Archives and Library to reflect the Governor's approval of that organizational change.
3. The merger of the existing nine GPR general program operations appropriations for individual Historic Sites and the Museum and the Inclusion of "memo entries" under the new appropriation to offset some possible legislative sensitivity with their individual listings.
4. The removal of the Public History GPR general program operations monies from the existing (1a) appropriation, its merger with the GPR general program operations appropriation for Historic Preservation and the inclusion of memo entries for these functions in distinct Society divisions.
5. As part of 4. above, the merger of the existing (3d) and (3dm) appropriations into the proposed (1ad) appropriation.
6. The merger of "like" appropriations now in as many as five chapter 20 programs into single appropriations. That includes the merger of the existing (3gm) appropriation into the proposed (1g) appropriation.
7. The elimination of other appropriations not needed after June 30, 2001.

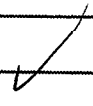

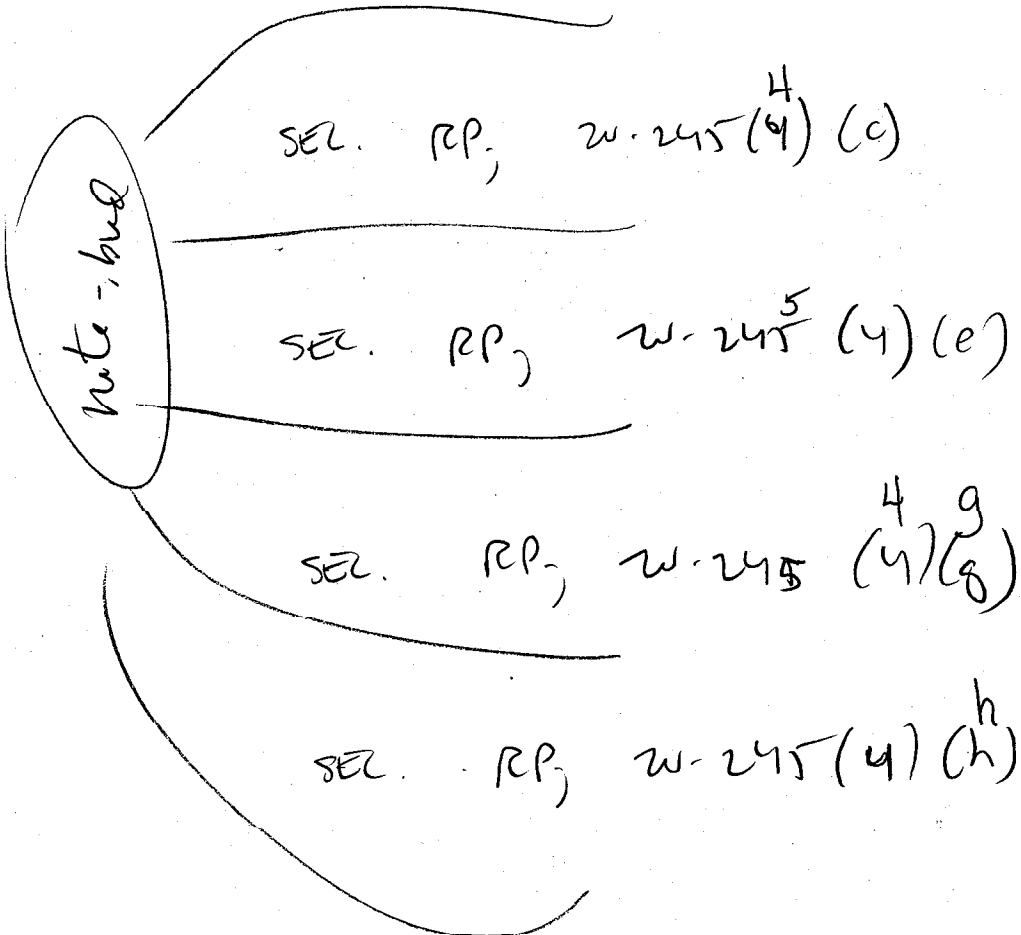
