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

HEALTH

Under current law, before January 1, 2001, the ~~Legislative~~ council on health care fraud and abuse, which is attached to DOA, must meet twice annually to, among other things, study and develop strategies to combat health care fraud and abuse by health care consumers and providers and by insurers.

This bill eliminates the council on health care fraud and abuse.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:
