**VETERANS AND MILITARY AFFAIRS**

Currently, DVA operates regional service delivery centers at which veterans may apply for state and federal veterans benefits.

This bill requires DVA to submit a report on the performance of the regional service delivery centers, including each center's video conferencing system, to DOA no later than June 30, 2003.

For further information see the *state* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

2 SECTION 9157. Nonstatutory provisions; veterans affairs.

3 (1) REGIONAL SERVICE DELIVERY CENTERS REPORT. Not later than June 30, 2003,  
4 the department of veterans affairs shall submit a report on the performance of the

1 regional service delivery centers, including each center's video conferencing system  
2 to the department of administration.
