Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the department of tourism must each year make payments in lieu of taxes that would be levied on land in the Kickapoo valley reserve if it were taxable to the treasurer of each taxing district in which land in the reserve is located. The payments are made from general purpose revenue. The bill changes the source of the payments to the conservation fund, which is largely made up of various fees related to recreational purposes and sales and use taxes related to recreational vehicles.

For further information see the *state* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:


