* Under current law, DHFS provides aid to eligible individuals ~~for the~~ costs of medical care for kidney disease, cystic fibrosis, and hemophilia. An individual who is eligible to receive aid, but whose income exceeds income limits established by * DHFS by rule, is required to expend certain amounts of his or income for ^{the} medical care before he or she may receive aid. The amount of income an individual is required to * expend is determined according to a sliding scale ~~that is~~ developed by DHFS. Every three years, DHFS is required to review and, if necessary, revise the sliding scale to ensure that the needs of patients with lower incomes receive priority for aid.

This bill requires DHFS to revise the sliding scale as necessary, rather than every three years, to ensure that the needs of patients with lower incomes receive priority for aid.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

1 **SECTION 1.** 49.687 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:

2 49.687 (2) The department shall develop and implement a sliding scale of
3 patient liability for kidney disease aid under s. 49.68, cystic fibrosis aid under s.
4 49.683 and hemophilia treatment under s. 49.685, based on the patient's ability to
5 pay for treatment. To ensure that the needs for treatment of patients with lower
6 incomes receive priority within the availability of funds under s. 20.435 (4) (e), the
7 department shall revise the sliding scale for patient liability by January 1, 1994, and
8 shall, every 3 years thereafter by January 1, review and, if as necessary, revise the
9 sliding scale. ✓
