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

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

Under current law, the department of commerce may award up to \$1,000,000 in grants per fiscal year, until June 30, 2001, to technology-based nonprofit organizations to provide support for manufacturing extension centers. The funding comes from repayments of loans made by the department of commerce for various business, manufacturing, and technology development purposes. The bill extends the manufacturing extension grant program by removing the end date of June 30, 2001, and changes the funding source to Indian gaming revenue.
