Pam, again, if this is not for you let me know (I think this is the last new item - yay!)

Commerce would like authority to charge agencies for the services of its international liaison position as detailed in their request:

Commerce currently has a vacant position in the s. 20.143 (1) (k) appropriation that it plans to use for this position. That appropriation is supported by contracts with and funds from other agencies. In this amended budget request, Commerce is asking for the authority to charge WTCS, DPI, DATCP, DOA, DFI, DOR, and DOC for the costs of the Liaison, which are estimated to be \$57,300 annually. Commerce proposes a charging mechanism similar to that of the Wisconsin Land Council in s. 16.966 (2).

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

The bill provides that the department of commerce may assess, on a premium basis, any state agency for the services of the international liaison of the department of commerce and specifies the appropriation account to which the moneys collected are to be credited.

For further information see the *state* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

2 SECTION 1. 560.165 (title) of the statutes is amended to read:

3 560.165 (title) ~~Division of international and export development~~

4 International services; fees and assessments.

1 **SECTION 2.** 560.165 of the statutes is renumbered 560.165 (1) and amended to
2 read:

3 560.165 (1) The division of international and export development may charge
4 fees for services it provides to cover the costs incurred by the division in providing
5 the services. The division shall ~~deposit all fees~~ credit all moneys collected under this
6 section in subsection to the appropriation account under s. 20.143 (1) (g).

7 **SECTION 3.** 560.165 (2) of the statutes is created to read:

8 560.165 (2) The department may assess any state agency any amount that ^{the department} it
9 determines is required for the services of its international liaison. For this purpose,
10 the department may assess state agencies on a premium basis and pay costs incurred
11 on an actual basis. The department shall credit all moneys received from state
12 agencies under this subsection to the appropriation account under s. 20.143 (1) (k).
